# Shepparton - a Jewish Perspective

Eight Jewish families settled in the Shepparton area in 1913 as orchardists. They started what became an active Jewish community lasting for over 50 years. At its peak this included a shule, mikveh, hall and Jewish Community Hostel. In the 1950s a Hachsharah training farm was also established.

In recent years former residents have started to document their experiences. Late last year a plaque was erected on the old shule site. A permanent exhibition will open on 15 May in the Shepparton Heritage Museum.
